Kitten Purritos

This pattern is intended for worsted weight (Med/#4) yarn and size 7 US needles. You can use other sizes of yarn as well, but it will affect your end-product. I've found that sport/fingering weight yarns tend to decrease the product by one size, so if I'm trying to create the small size, I will follow the instructions for the medium purrito. Bulky yarn works the other way, increasing by a size. So you can use up a lot of scrap yarn in a variety of sizes making these little guys!

- 1. Cast on 25 stitches (28, 33, 42)
- 2. Knit two rows
- 3. K2 *(K2Tog, YO2, K1)*, K2 (K2, K1, K1)
- 4. Knit. As you pass the YO stitches, drop the second one—25, 28, 33, 42 stitches
- 5. Knit 5 (6, 7, 8) rows
- 6. K5 (6, 7, 9), BO 4 (5, 5, 6), K4 (4, 5, 5), BO4 (5, 5, 6), K 6 (6, 10, 15)
- 7. K7 (7, 11, 15), CO4 (5, 5, 6), K4 (4, 5, 5), CO4 (5, 5, 6), K5 (6, 7, 9)—25 (28, 33, 42) stitches
- 8. Knit 12 (16, 23, 30) rows
- 9. BO7 (10, 14, X), knit to end (if you are creating XL version, bind off all stitches in this row)
- 10. BO 10 (10, 11), knit to the end—8 stitches
- 11. Knit 4 (5, 6) rows
- 12. K2, BO4, K1
- 13. K2, CO4, K2
- 14. Knit 12 (12, 16) rows
- 15. Bind off.
- 16. Attach velcro strips for closure.
